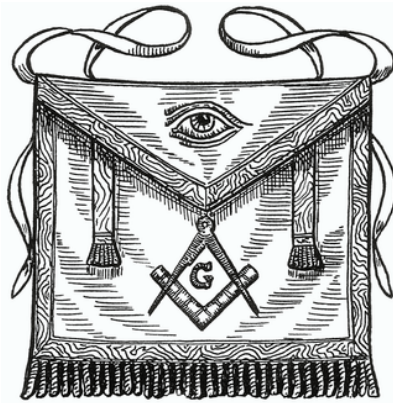

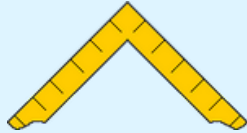

Happy July 4th to everyone. Please have a safe holiday and remember if you shoot off fireworks, there are those who have PTSD and it affects them.....

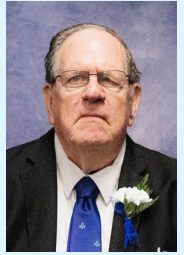
As a heads up, we plan on going DARK the first meeting in August. Most of the line will be traveling to the cave degree in Tennessee.

The Standard Perpetual Membership is 20 times your Lodge dues plus per capita.

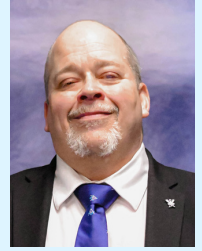

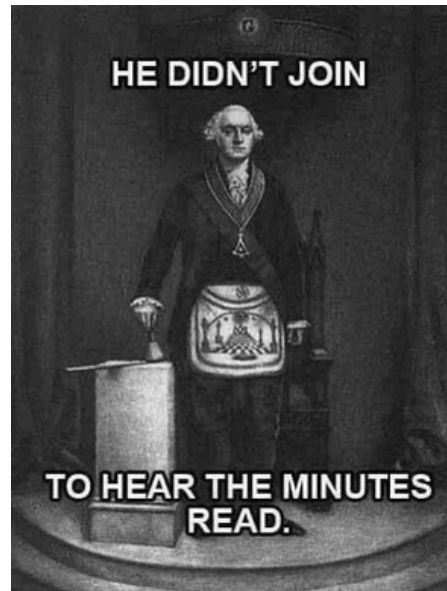

Famous Mason of the Month

Steve “Woz” Wozniak

Stephen Gary Wozniak (born August 11, 1950), also known by his nickname Woz, is an American technology entrepreneur, electrical engineer, computer programmer, philanthropist, and inventor. In 1976, he co-founded Apple Computer with his early business partner Steve Jobs. Through his work at Apple in the 1970s and 1980s, he is widely recognized as one of the most prominent pioneers of the personal computer revolution.

Steve designed both the Apple 1 and Apple 2.

After Apple Wozniak did things from teach fifth graders to founding a new company called Wheels of Zeus (WOZ).

Wheels of Zeus was made to create new GPS technology for everyday people. After Wheels of Zeus closed its doors Wozniak has gone onto other business ventures.

Wozniak is a member of Charity Lodge No. 362, Campbell, CA. He was raised in 1980.
