

Famous Mason of the Month President Andrew Johnson


Andrew Johnson (December 29, 1808 – July 31, 1875) was the 17th President of the United States, serving from 1865 to 1869. The 16th Vice President, he assumed the presidency following the assassination of Abraham Lincoln. Johnson was a War Democrat who ran with Lincoln on the National Union Party ticket in the 1864 presidential election, coming to office as the American Civil War concluded.

Johnson was born into poverty and never attended school. He was apprenticed as a tailor and worked in several frontier towns before settling in Greeneville, Tennessee, serving as an alderman and mayor before being elected to the Tennessee House of Representatives in 1835. After briefly serving in the Tennessee Senate, Johnson was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1843, where he served five two-year terms. He was the governor of Tennessee for four years, and was elected by the legislature to the U.S. Senate in 1857.


In 1934, Acuff left the medicine shows and formed a band. Initially they were called the Tennessee Crackerjacks until a local radio announcer called them the Crazy Tennesseans while introducing the band. The group liked the name and changed the name of the band. They ended up singing with the recording label ARC and worked to complete a 20 song commitment with the label before parting ways in 1937 over a contract dispute.

Johnson returned to Tennessee after his presidency and gained some vindication when he was elected to the Senate in 1875, making him the only president to afterwards serve in the Senate.


President Andrew Johnson's Masonic record shows he was initiated into Freemasonry in 1851 at Greeneville Lodge No. 119 in Tennessee, became a York Rite Knight Templar in 1859, and received his Scottish Rite degrees in the White House in 1867. He is documented to have been a Royal Arch Mason, a Knights Templar, and a Scottish Rite Mason.

What is the Golden Rule in Freemasonry?


